The power supply panels at the Pier, in Edgewater Park, and next to the entrance of Dock A have all been replaced. Buell Electric will also be replacing 14 older pedestals on Dock C and the south and west walls in the next few weeks. Additionally, you may have noticed Duke Energy working in the Marina and nearby areas recently. ## Marina Reminders

### Looking to upgrade your vessel?

Check with the Harbormaster prior to finalizing your purchase to make sure that the new vessel will be approved for your current slip.

**For security reasons**, the gate codes should not be shared with anyone in order to avoid the need to frequently change the codes. Any suspicious activity should be reported to law enforcement immediately, making note of date and time for security camera review.

**Bagged trash and boxes** must be brought to the marina dumpster. Cans are for small items only, no bagged trash or boxes please.
