Loss Prevention

Owners should check their vessels frequently, especially before and after rain/storm events. Batteries, chargers, bilge pumps and float switches should be checked and maintained to help lessen the risk of sinking. Marina staff members have been able to prevent a number of vessels from sinking, but cannot catch them all. It takes a surprisingly short amount of time for a small vessel to sink and is a costly event. It is recommended that boaters consider purchasing a towing membership such as BoatUS, which can help cover costs while a boat is in the slip as well as out on the water.

The power supply panel in Edgewater Park has been replaced. This completes Phase 2 of the power supply replacement project. Phase 1, power to the fishing pier and day docks was completed in January. The power supply for Dock A will be replaced in Phase 3. Once the backordered materials have been received by the contractor, the work will be scheduled. Dock A vessel owners will be notified once we receive the scheduling information. We sincerely appreciate your patience and apologize for any inconvenience during power outages.
