Additional Parking Space for Boat Trailers

The Church of the Good Shepherd has stepped up to assist the Marina with much-needed additional parking space for boat trailers. The church's parking lot can accommodate 25 boat trailers and is located on the east side of Edgewater Drive across the street from the Marina.

Presently, the Marina can only accommodate 17 parking spaces.

Use of the church property is **free** and can be used for a public parking lot on **Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays** for vehicles with boat trailers.



Slips & Ramp Fees Increase October 1

Monthly slip rental fees will increase \$0.04 per square foot while the boat ramp fees will increase \$2.00. The additional revenue from these fees will help pay for Marina Capital projects such as seawall renovations and the future dredging project. The City Commission approved the increase on May 8. The last increase was Oct 2013.

Marina Projects Update

- **Day Docks & Pump-Out Station:** Day docks are completed and ready for use. Equipment for the pump-out station is being installed and should be finished by July.
- **Dock "A" Rehabilitation:** Moffatt & Nichol updated their scope of plans which includes an option for new electrical and water pedestals. Bids will be requested this summer.
- **West Seawall Reconstruction Project:** Plans include rehabilitation

via cap repairs and a new anchor system, as well as replacing a segment of the Intracoastal Seawall with a pre-stressed concrete or composite sheet pile seawall. Mobilization and construction will commence September 28, following the Dunedin Cup Regatta. Should construction not be completed by early December, work will temporarily be suspended between December 3-8 for the Lighted Boat Parade. Work would then resume after December 8 to finalize construction.



Liability Insurance - Important Reminder

The City of Dunedin requires that all slip renters obtain a valid certificate of general liability insurance. A copy of the certificate must be submitted and kept on file at the Marina Office. If you are renewing your insurance policy, please be sure to forward a copy of your new certificate to the Harbormaster's Office.

Recreation slip renters must obtain a valid certificate of general liability insurance in the amount of \$100,000/\$300,000.

Commercial slip renters must obtain a valid certificate of general liability insurance in the amount of \$1,000,000 naming the City of Dunedin as an additional insured.
